Day 1: Come along as we enjoy the first two days of the annual “*Nebraska Junk Jaunt*”! Sometimes antiques and garage sale buffs are lovingly referred to as ‘Junkers’, thus the name. It is Nebraska’s largest garage sale, covering more than 220 miles across Central Nebraska. Each of 35 to 40 towns organizes a 3-day yard sale, where most towns have at least one “central set-up” location for vendors. It is 3 days of city-wide garage, yard, and bake sales with “treasures” of just about every type and description. Along the way, in unexpected places, there will also be fun and unique things to see and do. We’ll shop at a relaxed pace, going to as many locations as time permits as we search for the best bargains in town! When you board the bus, we’ll also provide you with a copy of the Nebraska Junk Jaunt Shopper’s Guide which lists the registered vendors in each town. The shopping route is along highways 11, 91, and 2, the beautiful Sandhills Journey Byway and the Loup Rivers Scenic Byway. It begins near Grand Island... we’ll take the northern loop as far west as Taylor, go south through Sargent on 183 and west on 70 to Broken Bow and then back east. This route will allow us to stop at some of the smaller towns slightly off the main route. A **continental breakfast** of coffee, orange juice, and sweet rolls will be provided en route. We’ll find lunch “along the way”. The group will be split for our lodging the night of the 28th. Part of the group will be in the Cobblestone Hotel and Suites (newer) and part in the Arrow Hotel (more historic). Please include your preference with registration. We will do our best to honor your preference. Dinner will be on our own in Broken Bow. **B.**

Day 2: Both hotels will serve a breakfast buffet, and we’ll begin another day of treasure hunting. As we make our way back east, we’ll plan to be in York for **dinner** at the ***Chances R Restaurant***. We should return to the Omaha / Council Bluffs area approximately 8:00 P.M. **B.D.**
